The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:

A26D0548. DAMION BROOKS v. YELLOW RIVER LANDS LLC.

On May 26, 2026, Damion Brooks filed this application for discretionary review of the trial court's January 7, 2026 final order and judgment. We lack jurisdiction.

To be timely, a discretionary application must be filed within 30 days of the entry of the order, decision, or judgment sought to be appealed. OCGA § 5-6-35(d). This statutory deadline is jurisdictional, and this Court cannot accept an application for appeal not made in compliance with the relevant statute. See *In the Interest of B. R. F.*, 299 Ga. 294, 298 (788 SE2d 416) (2016). Because Brooks filed this discretionary application 139 days after entry of the trial court's order and judgment, we lack jurisdiction to consider the application, which is hereby DISMISSED.
